

Prior to your second semester in your senior year, you must earn 175 hours of volunteer service. You may work on these volunteer hours between your 9th-12th grade years. When completed, you will earn 1 credit hour toward graduation. Further, volunteer service will make you eligible for scholarships and help you with college entrance applications.

This year, we are requesting that all 9th-12th grade students bring in a 3 ring binder with sheet protectors to create a Volunteer Service notebook. In the notebook you will keep track of volunteer service activities and the number of hours that you work.

As you complete each activity, you will type up something about the activity (when, where, how, who, how long, etc.) and have the organization or individual you volunteered for sign off stating that you did the work. This will be placed in your notebook. Pictures are great, but not required. All volunteer activities must be approved by the office to receive credit.

We will keep an official spreadsheet documenting each student's volunteer service hours to make sure every student earns the credit they need prior to graduation.
